## STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for the standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<b>ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral directors charges only)</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£ 1570.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£ 195.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at both the funeral director's branch premises	£ 295.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be a York coffin, oak veneer, gloss finish	£ 560.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the client)	£ 0.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£ 230.00
<b>UNATTENDED FUNERAL</b>	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	£ 2000.00
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fees) <sup>2</sup></b>	£ 2960.00
<b>FEES YOU MUST PAY</b>	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> <sup>1</sup>	<i>Prices on request</i>
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the <b>cremation fee</b> <sup>2</sup>	£954.00 - £1004.00
<b>ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTORS' PRODUCTS AND SERVICES</b>	
The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Limousines	£ 230.00
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£ 0.56
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home, to a place of worship etc.)	£ 120.00
Collection and delivery of ashes	£ 46.00
Embalming	£ 136.00
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	£195.00 - £245.00
Services supplied outside of normal office hours (i.e. arranging/viewing)	£10.00 - £40.00
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.	
Please discuss any <b>specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements</b> that you have with the funeral director.	

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave. **Cheshire & Staffordshire fees dependent on residency**

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This includes the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
